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## Committee Meetings

### Monthly

### Pairing Sessions 2x year

There are usually 2-3 sessions to pair all of applicants. These sessions take the place of two regularly scheduled meetings plus one extra session. .

## Committee Responsibilities

### Pairing mentors and mentees in Individual & Group programs

Committee members review applications to create appropriate pairings of perspective mentors and mentees prior to kickoff event

### Facilitating program kick-off events -2x year

This event provides framework for the newly grouped mentors/mentees. Committee reviews documentation provided to attendees, Programs panel of past mentors/mentees to share experiences at event .

### Monitoring progress of mentor/mentee pairs throughout the program

By sending communications to participants four times throughout program.

### Host Check-In for Mentors & Mentees

Committee Members host check-ins bi-monthly for mentors as an opportunity for Mentors to share with one another about their mentorship ideas, meetings, group dynamics, resources, etc.

### Meet Up Volunteers
